In partial modification to this Department letter No. 17900 dated 23.05-2012 and the Advertisements published earlier for sanction of Post Matric Scholarship to eligible ST and SC Students, the State Government have been pleased to decide to introduce uniformity on payment of scholarship in a rationalized manner to ST/SC students studying in various professional courses in different Govt. and private colleges/institutions recognized by competent authorities basing on the guidelines of GOI. As per the decision of the Government the maximum amount to be reimbursed towards Tuition & Compulsory fees for a particular professional course is mentioned below.

Sl. No.	Name of the Course	Fee Recommended for Government and Government Recognized Private institutions (per annum)
1.	Engineering	50,000 or actual whichever is less
2.	M.B.B.S.	4,25,000 or actual whichever is less
3.	M.B.A	60,000 or actual whichever is less
4.	M.C.A.	30,000 or actual whichever is less
5.	B. Pharm.	40,000 or actual whichever is less
6.	Diploma	26,500 or actual whichever is less
7.	BSc. Nursing	25,000 or actual whichever is less
8.	GNM	20,000 or actual whichever is less
9.	ANM	25,000 or actual whichever is less
10.	ITI (only for Govt. Institute)	2475 or actual whichever is less

The Post Matric Scholarship will be sanctioned as per the above mentioned rate with effect from the year 2012-13 for the above noted professional courses. The caution money paid by the students to institute shall not be reimbursed while sanctioning Post Matric Scholarship. Maintenance Allowance will be sanctioned as per revised rates in vogue w.e.f. 01-07-2010.
