RESOLUTION

Sub:- Reimbursement of fees under the centrally sponsored scheme of post matric scholarship for SC/ST students-regarding.

It was under active consideration of the Government to obviate the disparity in sanction of Post Matric Scholarship to eligible ST and SC Students and to introduce uniformity on payment of scholarship in a rationalised manner to ST/SC students studying in various professional courses in different Colleges/ Institutions basing on the guidelines of GOI. For the above purpose the state Government constituted a Committee to decide and recommend a rationalised Fee structure for various professional courses. The Committee in their meeting held on 09.10.2012, taking into consideration various factors, had recommended a rationalised Fee structure i.e. the amount to be reimbursed towards Tuition & Compulsory fees for a particular course as mentioned against each as per the table depicted underneath while sanctioning of Post Matric Scholarship to eligible ST & SC students studying in respect of all Govt. and private colleges/institutions recognized by competent authorities.
