
**Sub:- Implementation of STs and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006.**

Sir,


I am directed to invite D.O. Letter No.39211 dt.26.10.2009 of Principal Secretary addressed to all Collectors in the subject mentioned above and to say that Govt. in ST & SC Dev. Deptt. have been pleased to approve the following proposals for early settlement of claims under Forest Right Act, 2006.

1. Engagement of as many contractual R.I/ Amins as required for doing work under Forest Right Act, 2006 subject to their fixed out turn so that no idle wages can be paid.
2. Engagement of as many contractual DEOs as required for uploading of datas under Forest Right Act,2006. But it has to be ensured that one DEO would upload 50 datas per day and wages be paid accordingly. For OTELP Blocks, their funds can be utilized for this purpose.
3. Payment of TA/ DA to PRI representatives in Dist. Level Committee and Sub-Division Level Committee is admissible as per the Panchayati Raj Deptt. approved rates for attending the meeting of DLC and SDLC Collector may arrange for such payment.
4. Permission is accorded to spent money for awareness generation, printing of forms etc, and the expenditure will be borne under Art.275 (I) funds upto 10% of the allotment.
