Sub: Individual titles issued under the Forest Rights Act, 2006 to be considered as an eligible document for procurement of paddy

Madam/ Sir.

I am directed to say that in the State Level Monitoring Committee Meeting to review the implementation of Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 held on 7.3.2017 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, it was brought to the notice of Government that in some cases, individuals who have been given patta under Forest Rights Act (FRA) are not able to sell their paddy under MSP operations.

In order to obviate the above difficulties it is hereby directed that during the process of online registration of farmers for selling surplus paddy to Government the FRA patta shown by farmers shall be taken into account by PACS/LAMPCS officials. If the land details given by such farmers are not available in Bhulekh they may be verified through verification by Revenue Inspectors from their records.

Tribal farmers are a vulnerable group and their cases have to be dealt with extreme sensitivity and this Department desires that no such farmer, who is willing to sell his surplus paddy to Government is denied of the facility under any circumstances.

therefore, request you sensitize would, operation/Revenue/Food Supplies field officials in your district and ensure that Forest Rights Pattas issued in favour of beneficiaries are taken into account at the time of online farmer registration and marketable surplus

of paddy is calculated against such lands following prescribed productivity rates.
