**Proceedings of the State Level High Power Vigilance & Monitoring  
Committee meeting held on 25.08.2012 at 5.30 PM in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor  
Conference Hall of Secretariat**

\*\*\*\*\*

The State Level High Power Vigilance & Monitoring Committee meeting was held under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Chief Minister on 25.08.2012. The list of Members and other participants present in the meeting is at Annexure-I.

At the outset, the Hon'ble Chief Minister and the Chairman, State Level High Power Vigilance & Monitoring Committee welcomed the Members to the meeting and emphasised on the implementation of the Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Acts and Rules both in letter and spirit. He also briefly described the steps taken by the Govt. for implementation of the Act and sought the valuable suggestions and views of the Members for effective implementation of the Act & Rules.

Thereafter detailed discussion was held on the agenda items and following decisions were taken.

**Item No.1. Confirmation of the proceedings of the last meeting**

The proceeding of the last meeting held on 26.5.2010 was confirmed.

**Item No.2 Review of the action taken on the proceedings of the last meeting**

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary presented before the Committee the action taken on the proceedings of the last meeting and the action taken report was noted by the Committee. Some of the suggestions during this discussion are as follows:-

- (i) Steps should be expedited for setting up three Special Courts at Cuttack, Bolangir and Balasore Districts.
- (ii) The State Govt. have decided to open 390 Legal Aid Cells out of which 227 have been opened so far. Care should be taken to ensure that at least one legal retainer should belong to either SC or ST community. Adequate publicity of this intervention should be made.
- (iii) As regards setting up of ITIs the Commissioner-cum-Secretary, ETET informed that Govt. is taking steps for setting up ITIs in each un-serviced Block during this plan period on PPP mode. This will cover a large number of tribal sub-plan area blocks.

### **3. Review of PCR & POA Act.**

3.1 The statement showing cases registered by the Odisha Police under the PCR Act, 1955 and SC & ST POA Act, 1989, investigation completed by the Police, disposal position of cases by the Courts for the year from 2009 to 2011 were presented and explained during the meeting. It was decided to complete investigations within a time frame and submit charge sheets before the court of law. It was also decided to appoint Special Public Prosecutors in the ten districts where there is no Special Public Prosecutor.

(Action – Collectors of 10 districts / Law Deptt.)

3.2 The process of setting up of Special Courts at Bolangir, Balasore and Cuttack should be expedited.

(Action – ST & SC Dev. Deptt. / Home Deptt. / Law Deptt. )

3.3 It was decided to complete the selection of Legal aid Retainers in all the Legal Aid Centres and sensitise them properly.

3.4 Wide publicity should be given to relief and rehabilitation measures of the State Govt. along with the increase in compensation amount so that the atrocity victims can get the benefit of the scheme.



3.5 The benefits provided by the State Govt. for inter caste marriage should be examined to see if the SC girl or boy marrying somebody from the ST community will also get the benefit or not.

3.6 Expeditious action should be taken for a decision on 38% reservation for SC/ST students in Engineering & Medical Colleges.

3.7 The provision of Sanjog Help Line should be given wide publicity so that atrocity victims can get its facility.

(Action : ST & SC Dev. Deptt.)

**Item No.4 Review of District Level Vigilance & Monitoring Committee**

It was revealed during discussion that except in two districts i.e. Sundergarh & Khurda, all Dist. Level High Power Vigilance & Monitoring Committee meetings have been held during 2011. During this year so far 19 Districts have held the meeting once, two Dists. have held the meeting twice. It was decided to instruct all the Collectors under the signature of the Chief Secretary to hold the Dist. Level Vigilance & Monitoring Committee meeting regularly in each quarter.

**Item No.5 Recommendations received from different Departments / Organisations / Members.**

**A-Law Deptt. -**

- ↓ It was decided to move Govt. of India to make provision in the POA Rules, 1995 to nominate the Secretary, in charge of Law Deptt. of the State Govt. as Member of the State Level High Power Vigilance & Monitoring Committee meeting.
- ↓ Regarding payment of travelling and diet expenses to the witness, the modalities will be prepared by the Law Deptt., Home Deptt. & Director, Public Prosecution.

**B-Proposal of Director, Public Prosecution-**

- ↓ The State Govt. will examine the possibility of providing accommodation and other logistic supports to the Spl. Public Prosecutors.

(Action:- Law Department)

**C-Proposal of Addl. DGP, HRPC –**

- ↓ It was decided to review the performance of Spl. P.P.s by the Dist. Magistrates / Director, Public Prosecution at least twice in a year and take further action on the basis of performance.
- ↓ Regarding payment of diet allowance, TA to the victims of atrocity at the stage of investigation the financial implications may be worked out and intimated to ST & SC Development Department for taking a decision on the matter.

**D-Proposal of Shri Yashbant Narayan Singh Laguri, M.P. –**

- ↓ It was informed by the Commissioner-cum-Secretary that in the last TAC meeting held on 13.5.2010, it was decided to move Govt. of India for inclusion of HO language in 8<sup>th</sup> Schedule of the Constitution of India and accordingly Govt. of India have been moved.

**E-Proposal of Shri Aurobinda Dhali, M.L.A. –**

- ↓ It was decided to construct special SC Hostels for accommodation of SC students in the SC populated areas. The proposal regarding IHDA will be examined by the Govt.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to Chair.
