RESOLUTION

Sub:- Reimbursement of course fees under the centrally sponsored scheme of Post-Matric Scholarship for SC/ST students- regarding.

It was under active consideration of the Government to revise the course fees fixed by the Government vide its Resolution No. 23220/SSD dt.26.11.2015 and to consider any changes in the course fees which was brought under the above Resolution. The Committee in its meeting held on 22.09.2017 examined the various course fees for rationalisation of the Post Matric Scholarships to eligible ST and SC Students and to introduce uniformity in payment of scholarships to various professional courses. As per the recommendation of the committee the maximum amount to be reimbursed towards Course fees for a particular course has been mentioned against each in the Table-1, depicted underneath for sanctioning of Post Matric Scholarship to eligible ST & SC students studying in respect of all Government and private colleges/institutions recognized by competent authorities.

The Committee observed that under various ITI Courses, some trades require non-matric qualification while some other trades require a Matriculate qualification for seeking admission. As a result doubts arises as to whether the ITI courses were to be considered as Post Matric or Pre-Matric; whenever a candidate seeks admission for a Non-Matric Trade ITI course. The Committee unanimously resolved that the ITI Course be treated as Post Matric Courses for



the purpose of sanction of Scholarship to obviate the difficulties of the students and the Maximum amount of Scholarship will be limited to Rs.5000/- or actual whichever is less as mentioned above.

The Committee resolved that the maximum fees fixed by a Govt. college of a District for a particular general course will be the maximum fee for the similar general course in recognized private colleges of that district.

The Committee further suggested that the Scholarship Management Unit shall monitor and follow up the Scheme more vigorously in co-ordination with field functionaries and offer their timely suggestion for better implementation of the scheme. At the end, Committee suggested to place the recommended fee structure for the approval of the Government.

Government. have been pleased to accept the above recommendations and accordingly decided to sanction Post Matric Scholarships as per the above recommendations with effect from the year 2017-18, in supersession of this Department Resolution No. 23220/SSD dt.26.11.2015. However, the old cases relating to payment of arrear Post-Matric Scholarship up to 31.03.2017 shall be considered as per Resolution No. 23220/SSD dt.26.11.2015.

The caution money paid by the students to institute shall not be reimbursed while sanctioning Post Matric Scholarship.

Maintenance Allowance will be sanctioned as per revised rates in vogue as mentioned below.
