NOTIFICATION

The 3rd May, 2021

No.9897—STSCD-WOEP-ESTT/0002/2014/SSD.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Odisha is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Orissa Subordinate Welfare Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1992, namely;-

1. Short title and commencement:-

(1) These rules may be called the Odisha Subordinate Welfare Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Amendment Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Odisha Gazette*.

2. In the Odisha Subordinate Welfare Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1992 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), for rule 3, the following rules shall be substituted, namely:-

"3.Constitution of Cadre:- The Service shall consist of the post of Welfare Extension Officers."

3. In the said rules, in rule 4, sub-rule (1) shall be omitted.

4. In the said rules, in the Appendix-

(i) clause 3 & 4 shall be omitted; and

(ii) for clause 5, the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

"5. Select list: - (1) The final list of successful candidates shall be prepared on the basis of marks secured in the main examination as specified under clause 2 and such list after being approved by the Government shall form the select list.

(2) The list referred to under sub-clause (1) shall ordinarily be in force for a period of one year from the date of its approval by the Government or until another select list is prepared afresh whichever is earlier.

(3) Appointment to the post in the service shall be in the order in which their names appear in the select list."

5. in the said rules, rule 9, 10 and 11 shall be omitted.

6. in the said rules, for rule 12, the following rule shall be substitute namely:-

"12. Probation- every person appointed to a post in the service shall be on probation for a period of two years from the date of his appointment and if during or at the end of the said period, he/she is found to be unfit to continue further, his services shall be terminated".

7. in the said rules, for rule 13, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"13. Seniority-the *Inter Se*-Seniority of the persons appointed to the post in the service shall be determined in accordance with the position secured by them in the select list".

8. in the said rules, rule 16 shall be omitted.

9. in the said rules, in rule 21, the words "separately for each cadre" occurring at the end shall be omitted.
