

Proceedings of the review meeting held on 12.08.2021 at 6.00 p.m. under the Chairmanship of DC-cum-ACS, Odisha to review the implementation of the Scheduled Tribes & Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act,2006

A meeting to review the implementation of the Scheduled Tribes & Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 was held on 12.08.2021 at 6.00 p.m. through virtual mode under the Chairmanship of DC-cum-ACS, Odisha, wherein Director, SCSTRTI and all districts represented through its Collectors/ADMs, DFOs, PA, ITDAs, DWOs had attended. The list of Members who attended the meeting in the 2nd Floor Conference hall of the Lokaseva Bhavan is attached as **Annexure-1**. As per the agenda of the meeting, following issues were discussed and decisions taken.

Disposal of pending rejected Individual Forest Right claims by the DLCs concerned, as per the submission made before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP(C) No.109/2008.

- As per the Affidavit filed during July, 2019, 1,27,620 number of pending rejected individual forest right claims need to be reviewed & disposed by March,2020. Till the end of July 2021, only 82,778 claims have been disposed by the DLCs concerned leaving a balance of another 44,842 numbers of claims for disposal.
- After the last review meeting held on 19.04.2021, a total of 17,617 claims have been disposed by the districts concerned.
- District wise status is attached as **Annexure-2**
- All concerned Collectors were impressed upon to complete the process of review of rejected claims by the end of September,2021 by following the procedure laid down under rules and as communicated vide letter dt.08.08.2019 of the ST & SC Dev. Department.
- In case of non-traceability of the concerned case records of the rejected claimants, Resolutions of the Gram Sabhas are to be referred and the case records needs to be rebuilt by the end of August, 2021 & compliance reported.
- All Collectors were requested to check rejected cases randomly during their tours to ascertain its genuineness and also entrust Senior Officers of the district for such test-checks, so that adherence of proper procedure is strictly ensured.

Disposal of pending Individual Forest Rights claims

- 4,54,353 IFR claims have been approved by the DLCs till July, 2021, out of which 4,46,585 titles have been distributed.
- District wise status is indicated in **Annexure -3**.
- Collector, Keonjhar informed that due to non-generation of IDs in the website of MoTA, they are not able to distribute the approved IFR titles. ST

& SC Dev. Department would seek clarification from MoTA at the earliest possible and communicate the same to the District concerned.

- All Collectors were requested to plan for a drive to complete the settlement of 84,538 claims pending at different levels by the end of September, 2021. While giving possessions to the title holder, a photograph need to be captured as a proof.

Disposal of pending Community Rights (CR) and Community Forest Resources Rights (CFR) claims

- Till July, 2021, 9,099 and 5,974 numbers of CR claims and CFR claim were received, out of it 3,857 CR titles and 3,020 CFR titles have been distributed.
- District wise status is indicated in **Annexure -4**.
- 445 CFR titles in Mayurbhanj and 84 CFR titles in Sundargarh Districts are pending for distribution, even after approval of the DLCs since the year 2019. Collector, Sundargarh appraised that no proper demarcation and mapping of those 84 CFR claims have been done because of which distribution have been held up. In Mayurbhanj, due to its non-signing by the DFO concerned, those CFR titles could not be distributed.
- Forest, Environment & CC Department was requested to probe into the matter & initiate necessary action.
- The process & procedures adopted by the Kandhamal district administration in the recognition and distribution of CR and CFR titles are to be documented & shared with the Department for its replication in other potential districts.
- Special drives are to be made during October, 2021 for settlement of Community Rights in the State.

Correction of RoRs/Maps and demarcation of forest land in respect of the titles vested with the claimants

- Till the end of July, 2021, out of the 4,53,462 titles distributed in the State, RoR & Map corrections as well as demarcations have been made for 2,29,613 (51%) and 3,87,665 (85%) numbers of titles respectively.
- After the last review meeting dt.19.04.2021, corrections of RoRs have been done for 8,977 titles only.
- District wise status is indicated in **Annexure – 5**.
- A draft template for issuance of RoRs in respect of the forest land in the records of Forest, Environment & CC Department has been prepared and shared by the ST & SC Dev. Department and decision on it needs to be taken by the concerned Department at an early date and communicated to all Collectors and DFOs for needful action at their end.
- All Collectors were requested to complete demarcation of the forest land vested and correction of RoRs soon after the rainy season in campaign

mode. Engagement of additional manpower, if required, could be made by the Collectors concerned with due intimation to the Department.

Conversion of forest villages, un-surveyed villages / habitations etc. into Revenue villages

- Till the end of July, 2021, 24 districts have identified 646 forest villages, un-surveyed villages / habitations in their respective districts, out of which 66 have been converted into revenue villages prior to the enactment of FRA enactment, 8 are un-inhabited, 16 hamlets have been amalgamated with the nearby revenue villages, 19 are disputed, 7 of Koraput district are not traceable/ not reported and 1 is relocated.
- Out of the rest 529 identified un-surveyed /forest habitations, 152 applications have been received by the districts concerned and 12 such habitations have already been declared as 'Revenue Villages' by the Board of Revenue, Odisha, Cuttack.
- Collector, Sundargarh informed that they are in the process of conversion of all existing forest villages into revenue villages and in respect of one forest village "Sagjore", the process has been completed. He was requested to ensure its proper documentation & share it with the Department.
- Collector, Deogarh informed about conversion of 01 village named Jaritaila and pendency of 09 others in the office of the Board of Revenue. Similarly 40 forest villages of Ganjam District are also pending for consideration by the office of the Board of Revenue.
- Additional Secretary, R & DM Department was requested to coordinate with the officials of the Board of Revenue and expedite action on those pending proposals.
- All the Collectors were instructed to ensure availability of all the required basic amenities in those villages and proper documentation of the initiatives.
- District wise status is indicated in **Annexure –6**.

Coverage of FRA title holders under different schemes/ programs of the Govt. through convergence mode

- Till the end of July, 2021, post claim support has been extended to 2,82,417 (63%) title holders.
- District wise status is indicated in **Annexure – 7**.
- It is noted that good progress has been done in convergences especially in co-ordination with the PR &DW Department. However, the officials were requested to take up more projects also under Mission Jeevika, a leading initiative of the Department.
- All FRA title holders are to be provided supports, such as cluster bore well, dug well, small farm pond, nutri-garden, water access, land labeling etc. for their livelihood purpose.

- Concerned districts to formulate action plans for the next year so as to saturate all PVTG households by providing basic amenities such as Pucca house, safe drinking water, toilets, etc.
- All districts were instructed to formulate a convergence action plan for their district with a proper need mapping & particularly focusing on MGNREGS and Housing programs and share their plans with the Department by the end of October, 2021.
- A State wide campaign is to be organized during November, 2021 to cover all the eligible FRA title holders under different schemes of Government.
- Database of Forest Rights title holders to be created & updated, so that proper convergences of all the schemes & programs of the Govt. could be tracked.

New Initiatives

- To expedite the process of implementation of FRA, 160 Forest Rights Cells have been constituted in the Tahasil offices, Sub-Collector's offices and District offices of 14 tribal dominated districts. Capacity building of the personnel of those FRA Cells is scheduled to be held shortly under the aegis of the Director, SCSTRTI.
- SSD Department with the support of UNDP is piloting a Web based monitoring tool with the URL www.mojunglejami.odisha.gov.in in Bissam-cuttack Block of Rayagada District and Bonai Block of Sundargarh District, which would facilitate effective implementation of FRA and simplify the monitoring mechanism.
- Demonstration of the mobile application namely "Odisha Forest Rights Mobile GIS Survey App" developed under Odisha Forest Management System by the Forest IT & GIS Cell of the Office of PCCF & HoFF, Odisha was done during the last week of July, 2021 in three Districts namely, Rayagada, Koraput and Malkangiri. Its outcome & efficacy is to be reported so that it can be used for the determination of polygons in respect of rejected claims as well as in demarcation of the claims settled in respect of the forest land of R & DM Department.

The meeting ended with a Vote of Thanks to the Chair and all the participants.
