<u>Proceedings of the Review Meeting held on 29.09.2021 at 4.00 P.M. under the</u> <u>Chairpersonship of Director -ST, ST & SC Development Dept., Odisha on</u> <u>important issues concerning implementation of FRA</u>

A meeting to review important issues on implementation of Forest Rights Act & its corresponding Rules was held under the Chairpersonship of the Director,ST on 29.09.2021 at 4.00 P.M. through virtual mode, wherein Officer on Special Duty, (SSD), Project Officer (FRA), UNDP and District Nodal Officers on FRA attended. As per the agenda of the meeting, following issues were discussed and decisions taken:

<u>Disposal of pending rejected IFR claims by the DLCs concerned, as per the</u> submission made before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India

As per the compliance affidavit filed during July, 2019, review of 1,27,620 number of pending IFR claims ought to have been completed by March,2020. But till the end of August 2021, 90,566 claims have been disposed by the DLCs concerned leaving a balance of another 37,054 numbers of claims for disposal. On going through the district wise pendency attached as Annexure-1, it is noted that the bulk of pendency (numbering about 27,278 constituting 73%) relates to 05 districts & those are namely, Sambalpur, Nuapada, Sundargarh, Cuttack and Deogarh. All Nodal Officers were impressed upon to expedite its disposal at the earliest possible by following the procedures laid down under the Amended Forest Rights Rules, 2012. DWO Nuapada & DWO, Boudh apprised that all the pending IFR rejected claims (6918 & 1465 respectively) have been disposed in the meanwhile. DWO, Sambalpur & Jharsuguda reported that all the pending rejected claims will be disposed by the end of October. 2021. DWO, Deogarh reported that out of the pending 2091 claims, 1485 claims have already been disposed at the DLC level and he committed that rest claims will also be disposed by the end of October, 2021. DWO, Angul informed that only 112 claims are in the process of hearing and the rest 1073 claims have been disposed in the meantime. DWO, Puri was advised to take immediate action to dispose the pending rejected claims soon and report compliance.

Correction of RoR / Maps in respect of the titles vested with the claimants

As per the reports received from the districts, 4,56,232 forest rights titles have been distributed in the State till the end of August, 2021, out of which, demarcations have been made over 3,90,111 (85.5%) titles and RoR & Map corrections have been made for 2,36,336 (51.8%) titles only. OSD appraised the house that after the last review meeting taken by the DC cum ACS, progress in correction of RoRs have been made for 6,723 titles and those are in 08 districts namely, Balasore – 164, Jajpur – 344. Kendrapada-10, Dhenkanal-49, Keonjhar-113, Sambalpur-428, Malkangiri - 470. Nabarangpur – 3661 and Rayagada 1484. On request of the Chairperson, Officials from Nabarangpur, Rayagada and Malkangiri shared the process adopted in their districts as regard to record corrections. PA, ITDA, Rayagada informed that correction of RoRs/maps is listed as the primary agenda in all the Revenue meetings and it has been planned for RoR Correction of around 11000 titles by 31st December 2021. Considering the number of titles distributed, the focused Tahasils are Gunupur, Ramaguda and

Chandrapur. He was suggested to prepare a process document and share with the Department which can be widely circulated. PA, ITDA, Malkangiri submitted that they have allocated Tahasil wise target for RoR correction and staff of FRA Cells are extending necessary support in this regard. District wise status is indicated in Annexure – 2.

<u>Conversion of forest villages, un-surveyed villages / habitations etc. into Revenue villages.</u>

As per the reports received from the district, out of the 647 identified unsurveyed / forest villages, applications from 154 villages has been received and 13 such habitations (Angul -1, Dhenkanal- 11 and Deogarh -1) have been declared as 'Revenue Villages' by the Board of Revenue under the Survey and Settlement Act. OSD apprised that 49 more proposals (Ganjam-40, Deogarh -09) are pending with the Board of Revenue for final notification. The pendency status has been shared with the Revenue and DM Department with a request to take expeditious steps for disposal of those pending proposals. DWO, Deogarh appraised that in the meanwhile Director, LR &S, Cuttack has returned 02 numbers of proposals with certain comments, which will be compiled and resubmitted soon. PA, ITDA, Phulbani reported that about 17 such conversion proposals of the district will be forwarded to the Director, LR&S soon. District wise status is indicated in **Annexure-3**.

Coverage of FRA title holders under different schemes/ programs of the Govt.

Out of 4,49,167 IFR titles distributed to the eligible claimants in Odisha till August, 2021, post claim support as envisaged under rule 16 of the amended FRA Rules, 2012 have been extended to only 3,27,982 (73%) title holders. Director, ST impressed upon all the Nodal Officers to furnish detail information concerning the title holders covered under various schemes in the prescribed format communicated vide this Dept. letter no. 8290 /SSD dated 30.03.2021 on priority basis. Information from 12 districts are yet to be received and those are namely Cuttack, Kendrapada, Khurda, Mayurbhanj. Nayagarh, Sundargarh, Boudh, Kalahandi, Kandhamal, Malkangiri, Nuapada and Nabarangpur. District wise status is indicated in Annexure – 4.

Other Important decisions taken:

- i. Till 31.08.2021, FRA cells have not been constituted in Sambalpur, Jharsuguda and Kalahandi district as personnel are yet to be engaged to fast track the implementation process of FRA. Director, ST urged upon the concerned Nodal Officers to complete the constitution process at the earliest possible. DWO Kalahandi committed to complete the process during the month of October,2021.
- ii. It was shared that piloting of the FRA Website i.e. "freeodisha.in" is going on in Sundargarh and Rayagada districts with the support of UNDP. Updating the status, Nodal Officers of both the districts shared that after due process of right recognition, in Sundargarh districts, 29 numbers of claims are pending at the

DLC level for approval and in Rayagada district 28 numbers of claims are pending with the DLC.

iii. OSD informed that 8 Districts are repeating the data on rejected claims at different level through the concerned Formats of the MPR on FRA, due to which the total number of claims disposed is arriving as more than the total number of claims received. In this regard, clarifications have been sought from the districts concerned and those are namely, Subarnapur, Deogarh, Bargarh, Angul, Malkangiri, Gajapati, Sundargarh and Jajpur. Concerned Nodal Officers were requested to look into the matter & ensure submission of the correct data along with clarifications at the earliest so that MoTA can be apprised accordingly.

The Meeting then ended with a Vote of Thanks to Chairperson.
