NOTIFICATION

Sub: Payment of Maintenance Allowances towards Mess Management in the bank account of the Head Master SSD run Higher Secondary School (HSS) for the ST/SC hosteller of class XI & XII under the Post Matric Scholarship Scheme.

Post-Matric Scholarship is given to the eligible Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribe students to complete their higher education at Post Secondary Stage under Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS). The above scheme is being implemented both by the State Government in ST & SC Development Department and Government of India in both Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment and Ministry of Tribal Affairs for SCs and STs respectively as per the guidelines prescribed by them from time to time.

After careful consideration, Government have been pleased to enhance Maintenance Allowances (MA) towards mess management and credit the same to the bank account of School Head Master of SSD Department run Higher Secondary schools for smooth mess management.

Now, the Maintenance Allowances(towards Mess Management) over and above the post-matric scholarship under the Post Matric Scholarship Schemes will be credited to school Head Master's bank account of SSD Department run Higher Secondary Schools @ Rs.1100/- per month per student for 10 months to the ST/SC hosteller/ boarder of class XI & XII for smooth mess management.

The rate of the Maintenance Allowances (over and above post-matric scholarship) is indicated in below table:-

The amount will be borne by the State Government from its own resources w.e.f FY 2023-24.

Operational modalities:

- The District Welfare Officers shall furnish the correct data of Class XI and XII ST & SC boarders under SSD Schools and forward data details to this Deptt. through e-Mail **ssdpostmatric2023@gmail.com** for processing of disbursement of Maintenance Allowance towards mess management to Head Master's Bank Account of the concerned SSD schools.
- After receipt of details from the DWOs through e-Mail, the Scholarship Management Unit will download the data and scrutinize the same and forward the beneficiary list to the Section for sanction of fund.

The above order will be applicable to only 62 numbers of residential schools/hostels functioning under the ST & SC Development, M & BCW Department. The list is attached at **Annexure-A**. The list will be revised from time to time for inclusion of any residential schools/hostels functioning under this Deptt., on case to case basis, with approval of Finance Department.

Further, the payment of MA component under Centrally Sponsored scheme will be disbursed to the student's Bank account through DBT Mode as per guidelines of Ministries (i.e. MOTA and MOSJ&E) from time to time for ST/SC hostellers of class XI & XII studying in SSD run HSS.

N.B.: Any wrong entry or mismatch in case of boarders data and bank information the Department will not be held responsible for mis-credit and the DWO will also be held responsible in case of diversion of money on this ground.
